This week we are looking at Yemen and Iran, as our persecuted countries.

- As with a lot of these Islamic countries. Leaving Islam is forbidden there and if discovered, Christians face the death penalty, all Yemenis are considered Muslims by the state.
- Iran is slightly different than Yemen in that many Iranians are nominal Muslims and so some new Christians can find acceptance from their families. Converts from stricter Muslim families face persecution at home. Christians from Armenian and Assyrian communities are recognised and protected by the state, but still treated as third class citizens. They are not allowed to tell others about Jesus or to speak in Persian during their church services.
- Covid has hit a lot of these countries hard and many believers are in desperate need of food and medical aid.
- Pray that God would comfort Christians who have been imprisoned for their faith, may they hear God speaking to them. Pray for all those who are persecuted for their faith and that He would give them opportunities to tell others about Himself and pray He would provide food and medical assistance.
- Could we pray for all those in prison, every time I think of folk in prison I think of the story of the sheep and the goats and the only difference between the two lots of people was what they did or didn't do so I pray we would be the people that DO.
- Pray for the Christian courses like Alpha, Christianity Explored and the discipleship courses in prison, for repentance and renewal.
- We prayed some time ago that Diana's flat would sell, it has been on the market for two years so please could we all pray by the next prayer list she would have had an offer.
- Thinking of Malawi please continue to pray for Dennis, Sheila and their family for Syford, Elizabeth, I know we have been praying for their son Lovemore with addiction to alcohol so please just continue to pray.
  Pray for the irrigation system so they have enough food to feed the children in the preschools and those who are hungry.
